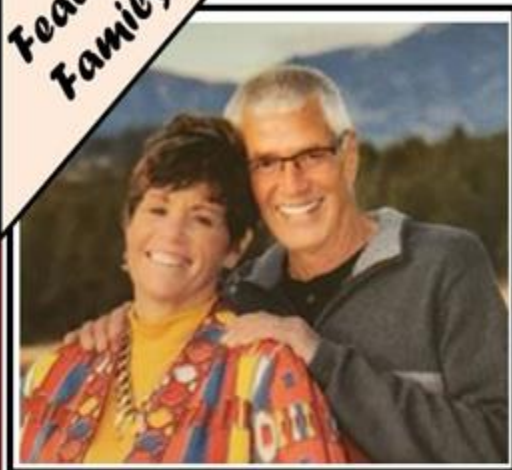

TRASH, REFUSE DISPOSAL. Trash receptacles should be kept inside or within approved enclosures. If kept outside, receptacles shall have wildlife-resistant covers to prevent trash from being scattered and dumped. Receptacles shall only be placed at roadway shoulder on the day of collection. No trash or refuse, as visible from the street, shall be dumped, stored or accumulated on any lot past the day of collection.
