




Our entrance is looking very sharp!

Ladies Coffee in June


June 17th at 9 am.

The results of this assessment will be presented at the annual meeting.



Construction Guidelines

This year we will be electing five Directors to the Board. The Directors oversee all Association matters and give direction and guidance to the Officers and various committee personnel.

The membership elects Directors at the annual meeting in July. In order to execute a proper vote at the meeting, a package containing candidate information will be emailed to all members in advance of the meeting. Property Owners unable to attend the meeting may indicate their voting preference by submitting a proxy. We want to ensure that all property owners have the opportunity to vote. Expect to receive the candidate information and proxy forms at the same time as the notice of meeting. We are asking that candidates requesting consideration submit a brief information sheet to President Dundics no later than June 5th so that their names and information can be added to the package. This form can be downloaded from the Forms & Documents page of the Eaton Pagosa Estates website.

We are also asking that anyone desiring consideration to be on the Architectural Review Committee (ARC) for next year let any Director know no later than July 1st. The Directors will be selecting ARC members at the Director meeting immediately following the annual meeting. That Director meeting is open to all members.
